Yard Waste Information Seasonal Yard Waste Pick Up (April - November)

Yard waste will include grass clippings, trimmings from shrubs and trees, and other greenery from general yard maintenance operations. It will be collected as a separate waste stream from the refuse and garbage defined above. It must be contained in approved biodegradable paper sacks, or in plastic bins with attachable covers or lids. These bins will be clearly marked as YARD WASTE. If any large bushes and trees are set out as yard waste they must be in bundles less than 4 feet long, weigh less than 50 pounds, and contain no tree limbs in excess of "2" in diameter. If the total yard waste exceeds fifty pounds, then multiple bags and or bundles must be used. Any such bundles must be securely fastened with twine, rope, or any other biodegradable fastening material.



Rubbish Removal

Please put all rubbish out in plastic bags or 30 gallon trash cans not to exceed 50 lbs.

All garbage is to be out by 6:00 a.m.

Garbage and recycling, although in separate containers, will be picked up on Friday, unless during a week where a holiday falls on Monday-Friday, then service will be on Saturday for that week only.

Residents are permitted **one free dump per month** at the landfill in Bad Axe not to exceed 1,000 lbs. (load must be approximately 1 yard or an average pickup load). Proper identification must be presented to the landfill.

NOTE: Only garbage and yard debris are permitted. Construction/renovation debris are not acceptable.

Residential Collection Procedures

Approved waste containers or bags must not be heavier than 50 lbs. Cans cannot contain "loose" trash; please bag all contents inside of your container.

Large items- **1 per week**; i.e. washer, dryer, stove, mattress, couch, etc. Call ahead to arrange pick-up.

Carpet- Must be cut into 4 ft. lengths (or less), tied and bundled. Call ahead to arrange pick-up.

No appliances containing CFC's (freon) will be accepted. Items containing Freon **can** be called ahead to Emterra Environmental USA Corp. Items containing Freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditions) will be picked up only when the Freon is removed and it is properly tagged by someone qualified to remove the Freon.



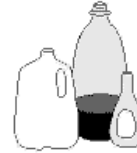

Newspapers (may be tied into bundles with string or other biodegradable materials or placed in plastic bags or other watertight containers)

Kitchen Cookware (metal pots, pans, tins, utensils)
