Residential Trash Collection Procedures

Please put all rubbish out in plastic bags or 30 gallon trash cans not to exceed 50 lbs. All garbage is to be out by 6:00 a.m.

Garbage and recycling, although in separate containers, will be picked up on Friday, unless during a week where a holiday falls on Monday-Friday, then service will be on Saturday for that week only. One large item will be taken on a monthly basis by calling (989) 450-3834 or (989) 665-1025. Items containing Freon (refrigerators, freezers, air conditions) will be picked up only with call ahead when the Freon is removed and it is properly tagged by someone qualified to remove the Freon.

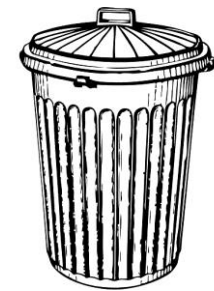
Approved waste containers or bags must not be heavier than 50 lbs. Cans cannot contain "loose" trash; please bag all contents inside of your container.

Please call ahead if you have large items- 1 per month; i.e. washer, dryer, stove, couch, etc.

Please call ahead if you have carpet- Must be cut into 4 foot lengths (or less), tied and bundled.

No appliances containing CFC's (freon) will be accepted. If needed, we can refer you to a contractor.

No tires, car batteries, concrete; loose liquids, construction or demolition debris, trees, stumps, or dead animals will be accepted



Yard Waste Information

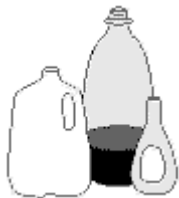
picked up every 2nd & 4th Friday

Yard waste is collected bi-weekly and includes grass clippings, trimmings from shrubs and trees, and other greenery from general yard maintenance operations. It must be contained in biodegradable paper sacks, or in garbage cans clearly marked with an "X". If any large bushes and trees are set out as yard waste they must be in bundles less than 4 feet long, weigh less than 50 pounds, and contain no tree limbs in excess of 4" in diameter. The bundles must be secured using twine, rope or any other biodegradable fastening material.



Plastic, Glass & Metals

is picked up every 2nd & 4th Friday

For safety purposes, glass must be bagged separately from other recycles.



Metals

tins cans, aluminum cans, any steel/ metal, clean
Please remove labels

Paper & Cardboard is picked up every 1st & 3rd Friday

newspaper, office paper, mail, envelopes, junk mail, magazines, glossy

Cardboard



old corrugated containers, paperboard, cereal boxes

If there are five (5) Friday's in the month, there will be **NO** recycling collected on that 5th Friday.
